

Part-time Panel Tutor for Cognitive Psychology

We are currently seeking applications from suitably qualified individuals with expertise in cognitive psychology to join on our expert panel of hourly-paid, part-time sessional tutors.

Around 300 ICE panel tutors, across a variety of academic disciplines, make a vital contribution to the quality of teaching, learning and student support. In addition to delivering face-to-face and online teaching, panel tutors also conduct marking and provide feedback on assignments, helping students understand the taught material and prepare for assessments.

We are particularly seeking PhD qualified professionals with expertise in one or more of the following areas - perception, memory and language, intelligence and social cognition. Preferably, applicants will have experience of teaching diverse cohorts of undergraduate students in an established university setting. A recognised higher education teaching qualification would also be beneficial. A student-centred approach and an interest in supporting adult part-time students from a broad range of educational backgrounds is essential. Tutors must be available to teach at weekends and evenings on our campus at Madingley Hall, which is four miles west of Cambridge city centre.
