How to go to Boracay Island

- 1. Take domestic flights to Caticlan (Godofredo Ramos Airport). Participants should take airbuses rather than small aircraft (Philippine Airlines have airbuses). NAIA 3 and NAIA 4 (Terminal 3 and 4) are the airports going to Caticlan. For transfer to Terminal 3 or 4, inquire at the information center of the airport or crews if you travel via Philippine Airlines from abroad, they will arrange your transfer to domestic terminals.
- 2. There are hotel transfer services available at the Godofredo Ramos Airport (Caticlan). Transfer services include: airport to pier/port, boat trip to Boracay Island, Boracay port to hotel. Transfer fees may range from 500 pesos-600 one way (11-13 USD). The hotel will be announced later.

How to travel to Boracay Island

- 1. Travel light. We suggest that you limit your baggage to one.
- 2. Light cotton clothes, flat shoes and rubber shoes will make you comfortable during your travel.
- 3. In case you have a number of luggages, you can make arrangements with porters.

Temperature in Boracay in May: generally about 32 degrees.
