Asian Education Review is inviting manuscripts for forthcoming issues. Asian Education Review is a peer-reviewed international journal, published by Korean Education Research Association.

Manuscripts should include a clearly specified research question, present a theoretical or conceptual framework, employ appropriate research methods, and contribute knowledge to the body of education literature. Manuscripts submitted for publication are subject to an editorial review process to ensure high standards for scholarship. The scope of the Journal covers all areas and fields of education.

Asian Education Review will consider the following for publication:

- Studies utilizing qualitative, quantitative, or mixed research methods
- Literature reviews that reveal critical gaps in existing research and apply a rigorous conceptual framework
- Analyses of significant issues in education using established theories from within education or appropriate related disciplines
- Reports of preliminary findings from a larger project (e.g., a thesis or dissertation)
- Education policy analyses focused at the national, regional, or institution level
- Analysis or critical review of historical issues in education

Technical guidelines for submissions:

Print manuscripts generally should not exceed 20 pages, excluding title page, abstract, references, tables, figures, and appendices.

- The file should be using a Word-compatible attachment/
- Manual of the American Psychological Association (with close attention to rules in text citations and bibliographic entries).
- The abstract should be less than 150 words.
