You will contribute to the teaching and assessing of courses primarily within the BA (Hons) Community Education Programme, but may be asked contribute beyond the Programme, if appropriate. You will also be responsible for supporting students on the Programme, supervising dissertation students and will be expected to make a contribution to the wider work of Community Education within the School.
