the NEET 2.0

Working with Europe is co-driving an ambitious national initiative in Catalonia, called NEET 2.0. The aim is to create a strong cross-sector platform in 2016, fundamentally rethinking and questioning what we offer NEET youth and potential NEETs. The platform will contribute to replacing short-term compensatory NEET policy with substantial and long-term 21st century capacity building.
