We will guide you through: documenting your data; formatting and organising your data; storing your data, including data transfer, encryption, and file sharing; ethical and legal issues in data sharing and handling confidential information; writing a data management plan for research grants.

Key Data Webinars 2015

The UK Data Service provides access to over 6,000 computer readable datasets suitable for research and teaching. To help you navigate the data that we hold we run introductory webinars on key data, which focus on our most popular datasets. The webinars are repeated throughout the year so you can choose a webinar session which is convenient for you.

Key Surveys

This webinar is intended for anyone who wants to know more about the UK government survey datasets and the cross-national datasets available from the UK Data Service. The UK Data Service provides access to a wide range of UK government surveys such as the British Social Attitudes Survey, the Labour Force Survey and the Crime Survey for England and Wales. We also provide access to a number of cross-national surveys such as the Eurobarometer surveys and the European Election Studies.

Census

This webinar is intended for anyone who wants to know more about the Census data4 February, 3 pmavailable from the UK Data Service. The UK Data Service provides access to Census data3 September, 3 pmin a range of formats including aggregate data, flow data, microdata and boundary data.3 September, 3 pm

Longitudinal Surveys

International Macrodata

This webinar is intended for anyone who wants to know more about the international macrodata available from the UK Data Service. The UK Data Service provides access to a range of international macrodata data including those produced by the World Bank, International Monetary Fund and the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development.

Qualitative

This webinar is intended for anyone who wants to know more about the qualitative or mixed-methods data available from the UK Data Service. The UK Data Service provides access to a range of qualitative and mixed-methods data including Peter Townsend's Last Refuge and Neighbourhood Boundaries, Social Disorganisation and Social Exclusion. 7 May, 3 pm 11 November, 3 pm

Business Data

The webinar includes an overview of the business survey areas covered (e.g. earnings and skills) and the data available. Examples of research that have used business microdata will be presented. As the business data are potentially identifiable, they must be accessed through the Secure Lab. The webinar will show you how to apply to access these data.
