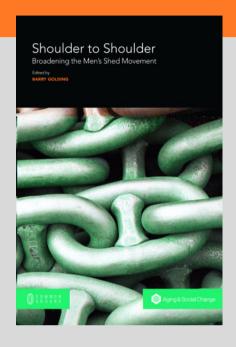
Shoulder to Shoulder: Broadening the Men's Shed Movement

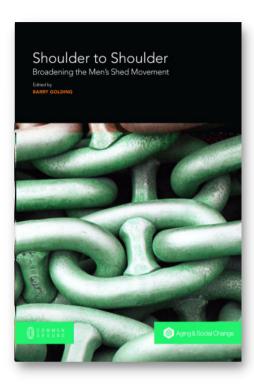
